Thursday: St. Mildred's Hall, Tenterden.

Every penny raised at Rockits events (Tenterden, Hawkhurst and Ashford) is donated to charity.

Subs can be paid weekly or half termly. Payments can be made by credit/debit card, but we are no longer able to accept cash, sorry!

We do not offer refunds if you miss any of your sessions. If for any reason, we (The Rockits) have to cancel a session, we will attempt to reschedule, or adjust your next payment accordingly.

All members are responsible for their own belongings during our sessions. The Rockits cannot be held responsible for any damage to property or persons during this time – or during external events.

Children over 10 are welcome to come along with a parent or guardian who is a member and is able to supervise their child at all times. Under 18's and students are free.

Lyrics, scores and MP3's for all of our original songs are available for members to print off for free from our website. Group Leaders can also help with printing and downloads.

All members give permission for photographs and videos taken during Rockits rehearsals and events, to be used for social media and promotional purposes.

We ask that all members refrain from sharing their own photographs and videos of the Rockits, without prior permission.

Max Wilson retains the rights to all arrangements she has made for The Rockits. These are not to be reproduced or used in any way, outside of our own events, without specific permission from her. MP3 downloads and lyrics are available to our members for practice purposes only.
